Philippine Weekend, Inc. Barrio Fiesta Terms & Conditions

Party 1 (Applicant) agrees to the terms and conditions of this agreement as listed below:

- 1. *Party 1* shall be defined as only 1 (ONE) single proprietor, owner, business, vendor, or entity. Any applicant who wishes to reserve an area to share with another proprietor, owner, business, vendor, or entity must seek approval from the Philippine Weekend Barrio Fiesta Committee.
- 2. A booth "area" or "space" will consist of a single 10' by 10' space that will be reserved for *Party 1* by the Barrio Fiesta Committee. The location of *Party 1*'s area will be at the discretion of the Barrio Fiesta Committee. *Party 1* may request to reserve multiple spaces, however, doing so will result in additional fees and will be subject to approval of the Barrio Fiesta Committee.
- 3. The fee for reserving a single area for a booth will be \$350.00, payable to Philippine Weekend, Inc. PAYMENTS MUST BE MADE IN CASH, MONEY ORDER, CASHIER'S CHECK, OR CREDIT CARD (VIA PAYPAL) (NO EXCEPTIONS). THERE WILL BE A 2.5% TRANSACTION FEE IF PAYING BY CREDIT CARD/PAYPAL. PERSONAL CHECKS WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED. IF *PARTY 1*'S REQUEST FOR CANCELLATION IS AFTER PAYMENT IS MADE, NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.
- 4. Once the Barrio Fiesta is over, *Party 1* agrees to leave the reserved and occupied area and the immediate space four feet surrounding the area clean and litter free. If *Party 1* fails to do so, *Party 1* will be subject to a \$25.00 cleaning fee as well as being banned from Philippine Weekend for an amount of time to be determined by the Barrio Fiesta Committee.
- 5. Party 1 will be placed <u>inside the Exhibit Hall</u>. However, Party 1 may indicate their preference for an outdoor space within the exhibit area. While we will do our best to accommodate your selection, please note that placement is <u>not guaranteed</u> and will be assigned based on sponsors, overall event needs and availability. If Party 1 is placed outdoors, Party 1 will have the option to rent a tent from Philippine Weekend.
- 6. *Party 1* must supply or provide its own tent or booth. The tent or booth must fit within the 10' x 10' space allotted.
- 7. If *Party 1* does not have their own tent or booth, *Party 1* has the option to rent a 10' x 10' tent or booth from Philippine Weekend for an additional fee of \$25.00. The Philippine Weekend tents/booths are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Once the Barrio Fiesta is over, rented tents must be returned to the Barrio Fiesta Committee in the same condition they were received. If *Party 1* fails to do so, *Party 1* will be subject to a \$100.00 tent replacement fee as well as being banned from Philippine Weekend for an amount of time to be determined by the Barrio Fiesta Committee.
- 8. Party I will conduct its business only in the space allotted to them by the Barrio Fiesta chairperson. Should Party I attempt to conduct business in any other area or in an area greater than the space allotted, then Philippine Weekend, Inc. has the right to terminate this agreement, and no refund will be given.
- 9. Party 1 will not infringe in any way, shape, or form upon the space of any other Party participating at the festival. Should Party 1 infringe upon another vendor's space, Philippine Weekend, Inc. has the right to terminate this agreement, and no refund will be given.
- 10. Philippine Weekend, Inc. will not be liable for any injuries occurring within the confines of the tent/booth.

- 11. Philippine Weekend, Inc. will not be liable for any of *Party 1*'s property that is either lost or stolen within the confines of the tent/booth.
- 12. Philippine Weekend, Inc. will not be liable for any unlawful activity or act committed by any person or business participating under this agreement at the Barrio Fiesta.
- 13. PARTY 1 AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND, AND HOLD HARMLESS PHILIPPINE WEEKEND, INC., FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, LOSS, COST, OR DAMAGE OF ANY KIND (INCLUDING REASONABLE OUTSIDE ATTORNEYS/CONSULTANTS' FEES) ARISING OUT OF, INVOLVING, OR IN CONNECTION WITH, PARTY 1'S BREACH OF THIS AGREEMENT, AND/OR ITS NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT.
- 14. Philippine Weekend, Inc., the City of Delano nor the County of Kern, will not supply any electrical power that *Party 1* may need. *Party 1* will be responsible for supplying its own electrical power.
- 15. Party 1 will be responsible for acquiring and meeting all Kern County Department of Health Services licensure, materials, and equipment to legally and safely operate their rented or self-provided tent or booth. This includes obtaining the proper health permits, materials, and equipment to legally and safely distribute or sell packaged foods.
- 16. Party 1 will be responsible for having all legal licensure needed to operate a business.

21. Note (Exceptions) approved by Barrio Fiesta Chairperson:

- 17. Party 1 will submit copies of all requirements (as requested) to Philippine Weekend, Inc. with the reservation/usage fee.
- 18. Party *I* is entering into this agreement and participating in the Philippine Weekend Barrio Fiesta willingly and of its own choice. Should *Party I*'s endeavor as a participant proves to be unsuccessful, Philippine Weekend will not be held responsible for any losses and no refunds will be given.
- 19. *Party 1* WILL NOT sell or distribute any liquid refreshments, such as iced drinks, SODAS, or WATER. If *Party 1* is caught selling or distributing ANY liquid refreshments during the festival, Philippine Weekend, Inc. has the right to terminate the agreement and *Party 1* will not receive any refund.
- 20. Snow cones and Halo-Halo are the ONLY exceptions to item 17 above and are still subject to Barrio Fiesta Committee approval.

22. All booth applications are subject to approval by the Philippine Weekend, Inc. Barrio Fiesta Committee.
